About Dataset Import Wizard

Dataset Import Wizard imports DeltaLINK, Ls2Win and HH2 datasets into Microsoft® Excel®.

What's new in Dataset Import Wizard 1.6

The width of the **Import into** list (**Options** page), is increased, to accommodate descriptive worksheet and workbook names.

Dataset Import Wizard is no longer installed automatically by DeltaLINK, Ls2Win and HH2Read installation programs.

Installation

System Requirements

To install and use Dataset Import Wizard you will need:

- Microsoft Excel 97 or later.

To Install Dataset Import Wizard

You need local administrator rights to install Dataset Import Wizard 1.6 on computers with Windows 2000, XP and Vista. Please contact your system administrator for further information.

Select the **Install Dataset Import Wizard 1.6** link in the Contents page of the Delta-T Software and Manuals CD and follow the on-screen instructions.

Alternatively, download Dataset Import Wizard 1.6 from www.delta-t.co.uk and click **Run** when the download completes.

The installation program creates an **Install Dataset Import Wizard** shortcut in a **Dataset Import Wizard** program group in the Programs menu, and copies Dataset Import Wizard files to the Program Files\Common Files\Delta-T folder on your PC.

To complete the installation you need to install the wizard into Microsoft Excel:

1. If you are using Office XP, 2003 or later, start by ensuring that macro security is set to medium or lower:
 - (i) Start Excel
 - (ii) Select **Tools > Options** and select the **Security** tab
 - (ii) In **Macro Security**, select **medium** or **low**.
2. From the Windows **Start** menu, select **Programs > Dataset Import Wizard > Install Dataset Import Wizard**. If Excel reports a warning about macros, click **Enable Macros**.
3. When finished, Excel reports that Dataset Import Wizard has been successfully installed.

Alternative Installation Procedure

If the **Install Dataset Import Wizard** shortcut fails, you can install the wizard manually:

1. Start Excel and select **Tools > Add-Ins**.
2. In the **Add-Ins** dialog, click **Browse** and open **Dataset.xll** in the **Program File\Common Files\Delta-T** folder.

If upgrading Dataset Import Wizard

Manually remove any earlier Dataset Import Wizard shortcuts: using these shortcuts may revert to the earlier version of the wizard.

To start Dataset Import Wizard

Start Excel and select **File > Import Dataset(s)**.

Known Issues

Faulty operation if the user chooses to not save the workbook prior to importing the dataset.

Dataset Import Wizard requires the target workbook to be freshly saved prior to importing a dataset, prompting the user to do so. Normally, if the user declines, Dataset Import Wizard cancels the operation. Under Excel 97, if the workbook has been previously saved in a later version of Excel, Excel warns the user that workbook features may be lost. In this situation, Dataset Import Wizard is unable to determine whether the user has declined to proceed with the Save, and continues regardless. Without saving the workbook, Dataset Import Wizard may be unable to correctly determine the worksheet structure, and the import operation may proceed erroneously.

Resolution: do not decline to save the workbook when warned that workbook features may be lost because the workbook has previously been saved in a later version of Excel.

Error message when installing Dataset Import Wizard into Excel: This Workbook has lost its VBA project, ActiveX controls and any other programmability-related features.

This message occurs if the Visual Basic for Applications option is not installed alongside your Excel installation.

Resolution: Install Visual Basic for Applications from your Microsoft Office or Excel installation CD and run Install Dataset Import Wizard again.

Please refer to the Microsoft Office or Excel documentation for information about installing individual components, or contact your computer support personnel.

Online Help fails to load when installed under Windows Vista

When clicking Help to start online help, Dataset Import Wizard reports that Help failed to load. Windows also displays a message informing stating that the Help was designed for an earlier version of windows, and that Windows Help is no longer supported by this version of Windows.

Resolution: none.
